Port Hacking High School uses a variety of digital resources to support teaching and learning:

- Mangahigh for students in Years 7 to Year 10 Mathematics
- Oxford Digital for students in Year 11 and Year 12 Mathematics

These web-based learning platforms provide students with access to a range of curriculum resources. Students can work on concepts and skills at their own pace. Teachers can assign students tasks and receive feedback about the progress of individual students.

Your child will be issued access accounts that match their pattern of study. The cost has been included in their school fees, so no additional payment is required.

Mangahigh and Oxford Digital require Port Hacking High School to provide the following information to create an account for your child:

- your child's name
- school email address (Oxford – Year 12 Standard only)
- Year group
- class
