



Year 7 High Potential and Gifted Education Program Extension Class Nomination Information - 2026

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

We would like to invite you to submit additional information about your child for us to use in selecting students for our High Potential and Gifted Education (HPGE) extension class for Year 7 2026.

The HPGE extension class is designed to stimulate the interests and abilities of our capable students, supporting them to engage in learning to maximise their potential. We aim to create a challenging differentiated learning environment that encourages students to strive towards the development of their abilities, promoting creativity and higher order thinking skills.

Goals of the Program:

- to provide a challenging curriculum and enriching educational environment that extends and supports capable students, intellectually and socially, to develop to their full potential
- to differentiate the curriculum at a pace and depth appropriate to the capabilities of high potential learners
- to provide a learning environment that encourages divergent, critical and creative thinking
- to develop student self-understanding and metacognition

Identification:

The identification of students for our HPGE extension class is based upon a range of measures. This process includes procedures for identifying student who demonstrate, or have the potential to demonstrate, exceptional performance in one or more talent areas. In identifying students for our Year 7 program, we will use parent and student nominations, primary school reports, NAPLAN data and testing conducted by us during the orientation period.

Applicants for the extension class will undertake a test developed and marked by the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER).

The test is 50 minutes duration and aims to:

- Identify individual strengths and weaknesses
- Identify a student's ability to think critically and apply higher order thinking skills

Registrations close 3:00pm Friday 4th April 2025.

Test will be held at Port Hacking High School commencing 1:30pm Monday 5 May 2025.

To nominate your child:

Registrations for the test are due by 3:00pm, Friday 4 April 2025 (see our website for registration details). Additional information and test details will be sent to registered students in the last week of Term 1.

YOU MUST complete the attached nomination forms. We also ask that you attach copies of the following documents as additional information to assist the panel in our selections:

- Your child's Year 3 and 5 NAPLAN test results (if possible).
- Your child's TWO most recent school reports
- Certificates of achievement or participation in extension courses/programs or external competitions
- Achievement in extra-curricular activities





Please submit applications to the supervising teacher on test day, clearly labelled with your child's name and 'HPGE Extension Class'. Late registrations and application documentation will not be accepted.

Initial places in the program will be offered, based on this nomination process, by June 27.
