Dear Year 10 students and their Parents/Carers,

Careers Education is an important part of every students' education. At Port Hacking High School, Year 10 students have been involved in careers activities since Year 8 and will continue until the end of Year 12, or until the student leaves high school.

Careers Education is particularly important in Year 10 as many important ideas and decisions are considered during this time. Throughout the year, Year 10 students will be involved in lessons, activities, incursions and excursions.

Careers Lessons: Students are withdrawn from classes to complete the Careers Education syllabus.

Excursions/Activities/Workshops: These are provided for all Year 10 students to attend, some are optional. These often incur costs and are sometimes subsidised from the School to Work program to make them more affordable to students. These events will also require a permission note. All activities, workshops and excursions will be advertised through Daily Notices, weekly student email and assemblies.

Work Experience: Is available to every Year 10 student throughout 2021 in designated weeks of each term. This requires comprehensive paperwork which must be in place prior to work experience.

Students contemplating *Work Experience on a construction site* must have a White Card.

Please note: The NSW Department of Education does not recognise on-line White Card courses.

White Card courses are held at school throughout the year. The cost is \$110, which the School to Work program subsidises by \$25 thus reducing the cost to students to \$85. These courses are advertised through Daily Notices.
